## Who are the Gifted?

The Ohio state guidelines define the gifted as those students who meet the following requirements of being superior in one or more of the following types of abilities:

- a) Superior Cognitive Ability
- b) Specific Academic which is superior to that of children of similar age
- c) Creative Thinking which is superior to that of children of similar age
- d) Visual and/or performing arts ability which is superior to that of children of similar age

## Elementary Talent Development Program

### *Indirect Gifted Services*

Students in grades K-6 may be cluster grouped within a grade level at their home school for specific subject curriculum differentiation and access to above grade level curriculum with a regular education teacher who has on-going high quality professional development.

### *Direct Gifted Services*

#### **Self-contained classroom for 4 - 6th grade students**

Curriculum is presented in a variety of teaching styles and differentiates from basic curriculum.

This program is located at Edison Elementary School

#### **Math Resource Room**

For math identified gifted students in grades 4 and 6. This program is located at Taft Elementary School
